


GENERAL

- 1. Park motorcycle on a flat surface, fully extend kickstand, and make sure vehicle is stable.
- 2. Turn key or ignition switch to OFF position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

Left side closeout shown. Right side similar.

1. Install closeout into place and pull upper flaps around bar.



2. Pull lower flaps around lower bar.




3. Snap upper snaps together.



4. Snap lower snaps together.



5. Make any adjustments to closeout so it is installed evenly on highway bar.



6. If installed, highway bar pegs should be installed to bar in opening of closeout.

7. Repeat steps for opposite side closeout.
