




- Cleaning Solution (99% water + 1% mild dishwashing detergent)

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

- 1. Park vehicle on a flat surface.
- 2. Shift vehicle into PARK.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

NOTICE

Kolpin recommends enlisting a helper when handling the windshield assembly.

1. Set windshield on soft surface. Clean the inside of the windshield frame with mild cleaning solution and wipe with isopropyl alcohol.


M WARNING

Isopropyl alcohol is hazardous to your health. See isopropyl alcohol packaging for proper handling instructions, including recommended personal protective equipment such as goggles and chemical resistant gloves.


2. Put foam strips 5 on sides of windshield.

TIP

Test fit windshield to vehicle to determine proper placement of foam strips.




- 3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.
- 3. Put foam strip 9 across top of windshield.



4. Put bulb seal ® on lower edge of windshield. Trim ends as shown.

TIP

The bulb seal has a metal core. Kolpin recommends using a metal shears to trim the bulb seal.






5. Put windshield on vehicle. Make sure bulb seal fits along top of dashboard.


NOTICE

Enlist a helper to fit windshield to vehicle.




NOTICE

If installing the windshield on a vehicle with a Polaris Poly Roof, remove the cover plates (A).




6. Attach windshield at corners using screws ②, washers ③ and nuts ④.

Do not torque fasteners at this time.




7. Install clamp ① on top of windshield using screws②, washers ③ and nuts ④.

Do not torque fasteners at this time.



8. Install side clamps (6) using screws (2), washers (3) and nuts (4).

Do not torque fasteners at this time.




9. Torque all fasteners to specification.

TORQUE
Windshield Fasteners:
7 ft-lbs (9.4 N·m)

OPERATION


1. Turn vent lock counter clockwise to loosen.




IMPORTANT

- Check accessory mounts frequently and retighten hardware if necessary.
- Replace this accessory with a new one if it becomes damaged.
- Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline thinner, benzene, acid or alkaline cleaners

2. Slide vent to open.



3. Turn lock clockwise to set vent location.



MARNING

Vehicle must face forward if transported on open trailer. If vehicle cannot face forward, windshield must be removed. Failure to comply may cause windshield to separate from vehicle which can result in injury or death.



ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

For the period of one (1) year from the purchase date, Kolpin will replace for the original purchaser, free of charge, any part or parts found upon examination by Kolpin to be defective in material, workmanship, or both.

All transportation costs incurred submitting product to Kolpin for warranty consideration must be borne by the purchaser. If Kolpin determines that the product must be returned to the factory for credit, please call 1-877-956-5746 for a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions.

This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect your ATV, certain parts of the accessory system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the plow system and related components.

Peripheral products such as engines, electric motors, and actuators may carry and original manufacturer's warranty. Most hardware is general in nature and is easily obtained locally. Be sure to replace with minimum metric class 8.8 specification.

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
