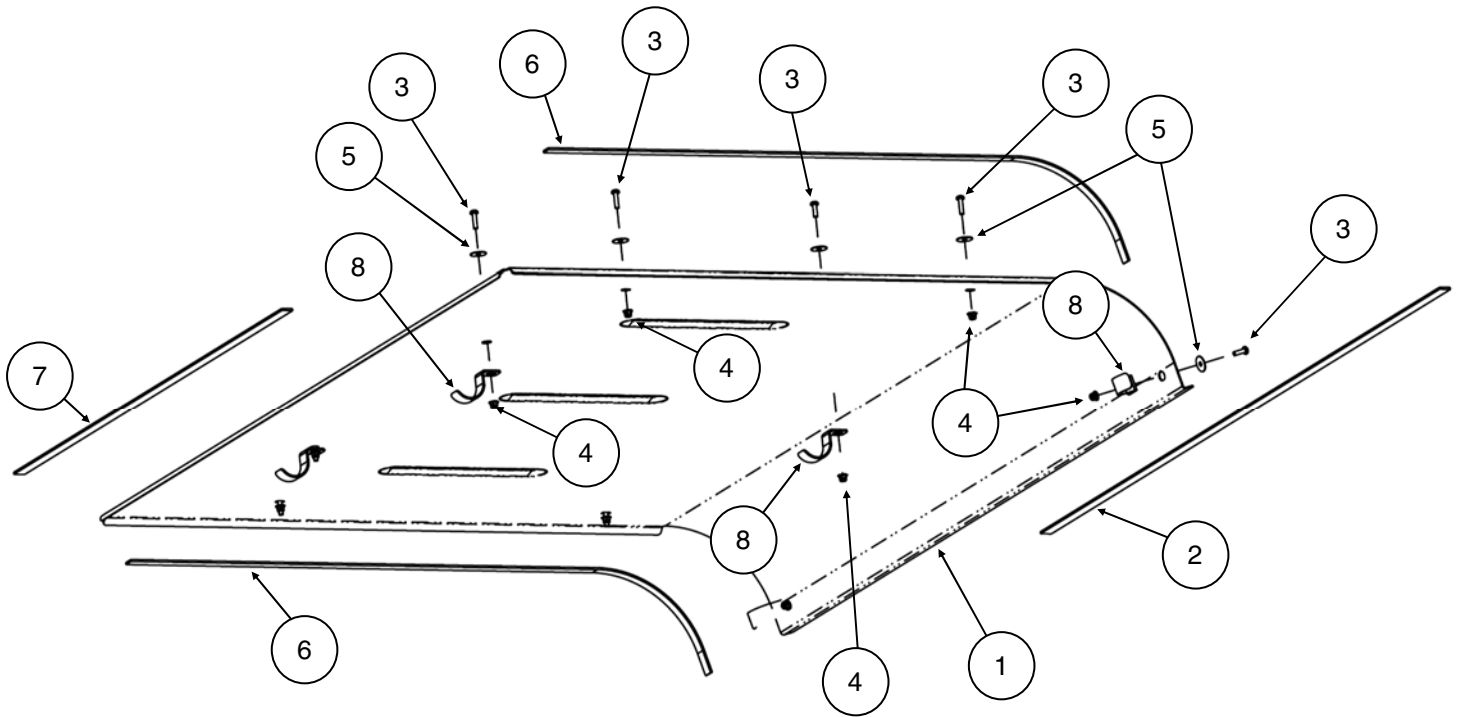

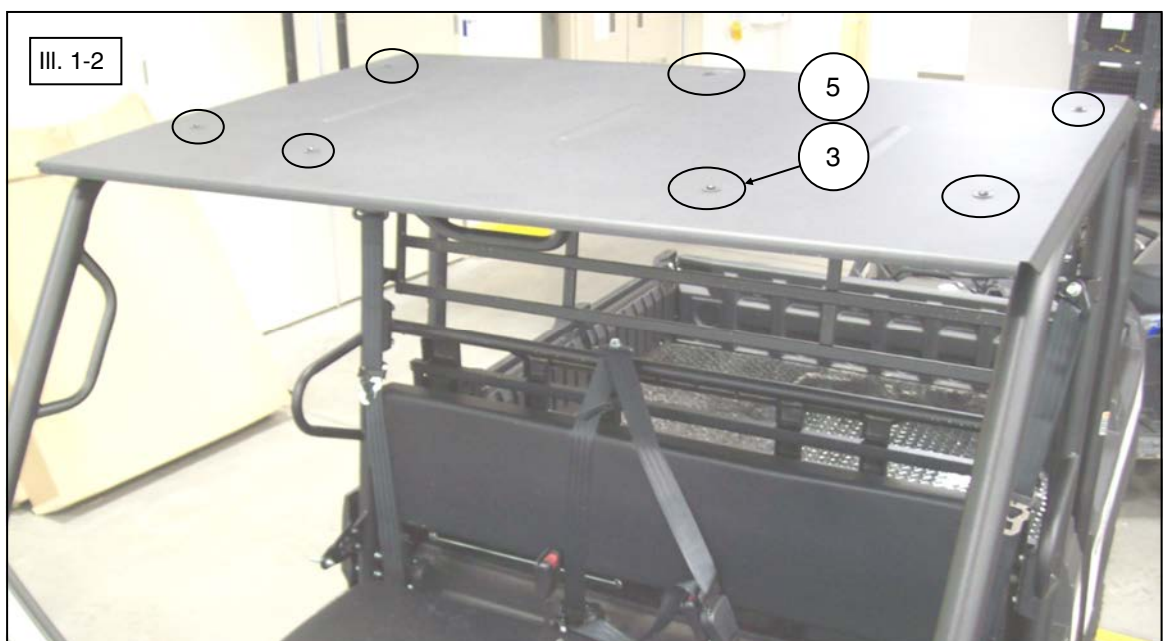
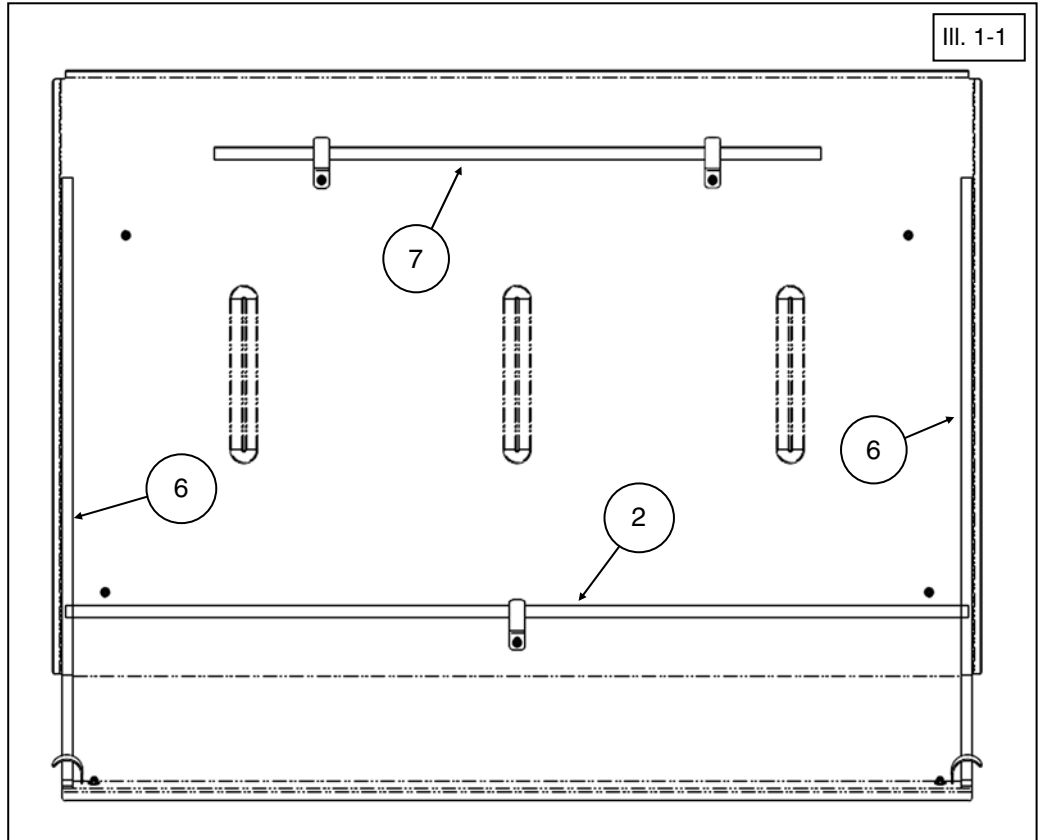

Assembly Time: Approximately 18 minutes

Important: Your Kolpin Steel Roof Kit is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown. For better cab assembly procedure, install kits in the following order: front window, and roof.

Installation Instructions:

1. Shift vehicle transmission into “NUETRAL” and set parking brake. Turn key to “OFF” position and remove from vehicle.
2. Clean lower surface of roof (item #1) as required, then apply foam strips (items #6, #7 and #2) as shown. Trim seals as required. (See illustration 1-1). **Note, foam strip alignment may be easier if roof assembly is placed on cab frame, then mark with pencil or tape where the roll cage tubes make contact with metal roof.**
3. Place roof assembly on the top of the vehicle cab frame as shown. (See illustration 1-2).
4. For the mounting locations shown, use the M6 screws (item #3) and flat washers (item #5) on the top side of roof. (See illustration 1-2).

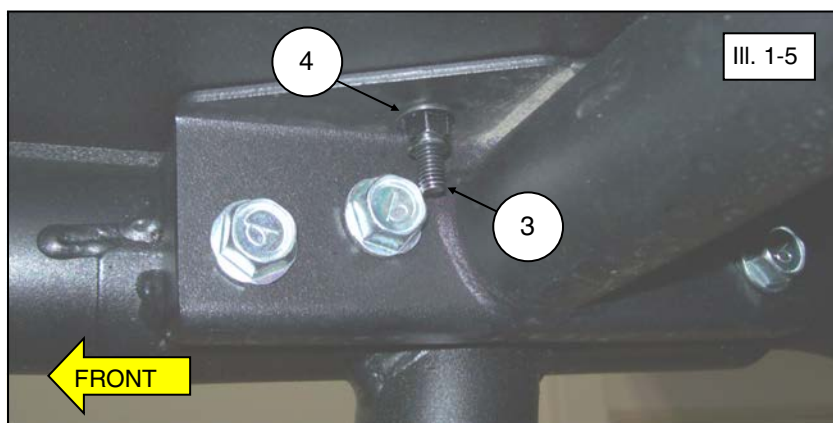
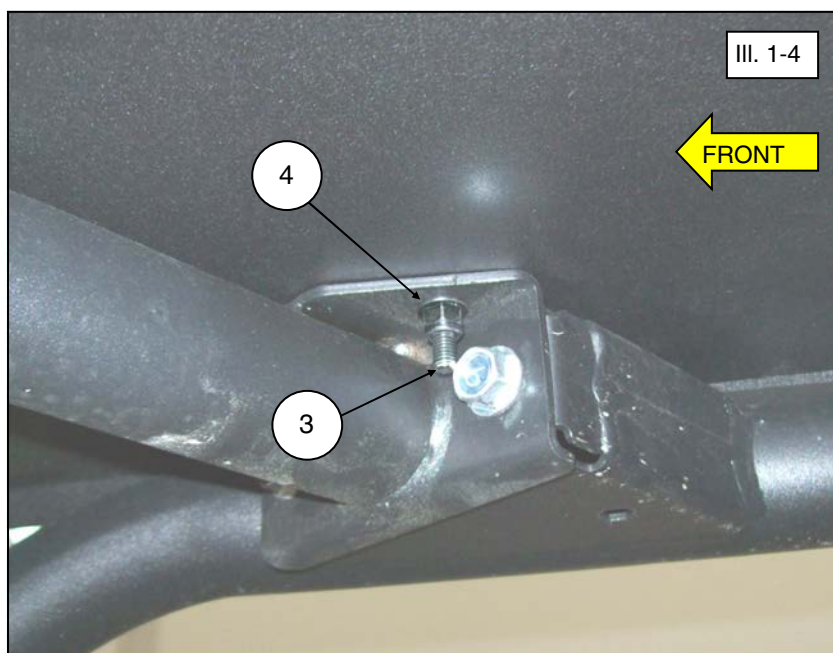


Installation Instructions (Continued):

5. For the middle front holes of the roof, attach the two clamps (item #8) to the assembly as shown. From the top surface, secure the middle clamps using the M6 screws (item #3) and M6 washers (item #5). Fasten the clamps with M6 locknuts (item #4). (See illustration 1-3). **Note: Do not tighten hardware at this step since adjustments may be required later.**

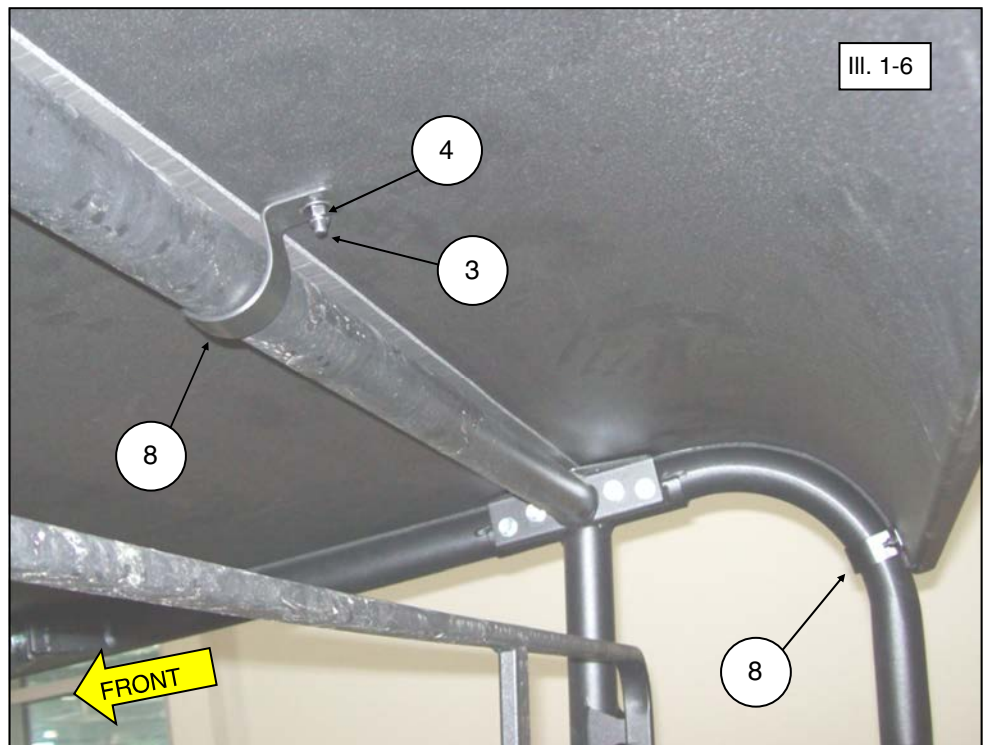


6. From underneath roof, loosely fasten front screws (item #3) with two M6 locknuts (item #4) at the front corner cab frame gusset tabs as shown. (See illustration 1-4). **Note: Do not tighten hardware at this step since adjustments may be required later.**
7. From underneath roof, loosely fasten front screws (item #3) with two M6 locknuts (item #4) at the middle cab frame side gusset tabs as shown. (See illustration 1-5). **Note: Do not tighten hardware at this step since adjustments may be required later.**

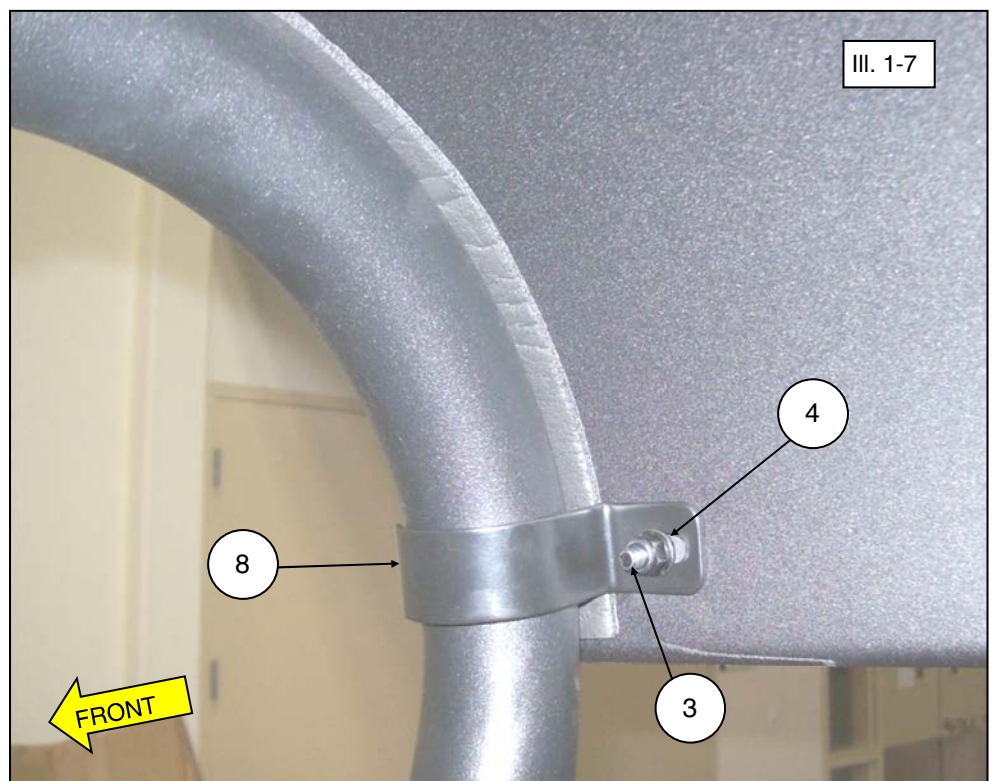


Installation Instructions (Continued):

- Position and align one clamp (item #8) onto the middle cab frame tube and fasten using M6 screw (item #3) and M6 flat washer (item #5) from top surface. Secure clamp using M6 locknut (item #4) as shown. (See illustration 1-6). **Note: Do not tighten hardware at this step since adjustments may be required later.**



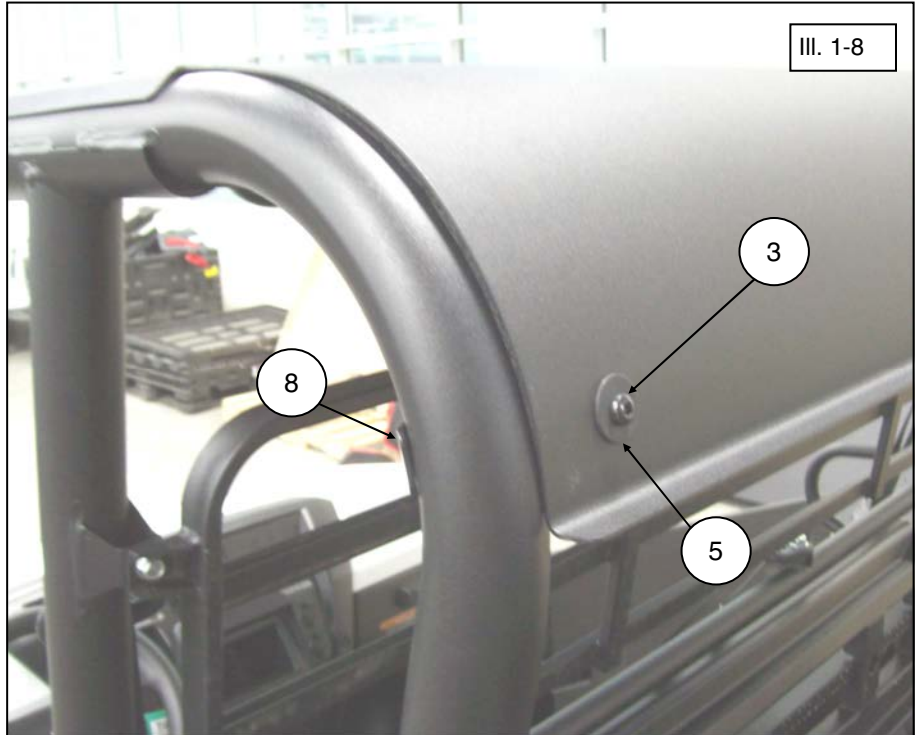
- Secure each rear side of the roof panel to cab frame using clamps (item #8) and M6 locknuts (item #4) as shown. Tighten the M6 screw (item #3) with washer (item #5). (See illustrations 1-7 and 1-8). **Note: Do not tighten hardware at this step since adjustments may be required later.**



Installation Instructions (Continued):

10. Tighten all hardware to specification.

One Year Limited Warranty

For the period of one (1) year from the purchase date, Kolpin will replace for the original purchaser, free of charge, any part or parts found upon examination by Kolpin to be defective in material, workmanship, or both.

All transportation costs incurred submitting product to Kolpin for warranty consideration must be borne by the purchaser. If Kolpin determines that the product must be returned to the factory for credit, please call 1-877-956-5746 for a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions.

This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect you and your ATV, certain parts of the accessory system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the plow system and related components.

Peripheral products such as engines, electric motors, and actuators may carry an original manufacturer's warranty. Most hardware is general in nature and is easily obtained locally. Be sure to replace with minimum metric class 8.8 specification.
