

The following instructions contain details required to install and service the contents of this kit.



INTRO

- To facilitate installation, make sure that your vehicle is clean and free of debris.
- All directions referring to right and left are from the rider perspective when sitting on the machine.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all Cautions, Notices, and Warnings in this manual before you begin. In order to protect you and your ATV / UTV, certain parts of the plow system and / or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed.

Follow these guidelines to ensure satisfactory operation:

- Read this manual and your ATV / UTV operators manual before use.
- Periodically check for wear and tightness of all fasteners. Replace or re-torque fasteners as necessary.
- Before first use, set plow in the furthest right or left angled position to check for interference with the vehicle.
- Operate with extreme caution on slopes and rough terrain. Be familiar with the area before you plow.
- Be aware of immovable objects that could be hidden in the area you are plowing.
- To avoid damage when pushing snow into a pile, reverse direction before raising the plow blade.
- Do not ram the plow blade into piles of snow.
- For best results, set the suspension preload of your ATV / UTV to the stiffest setting.
- To reduce steering effort and increase mobility, set the air pressure of your tires to the maximum pressure specification.
- The plow skids are adjustable. General skid setting is even with the plow wear bar bottom edge, higher settings reduce the chance of rocks and gravel from being collected.
- To increase traction during plow operation, operators can try: Securing weight to the ATV / UTV for additional tire downforce, reducing tire air pressure, or installing tire chains.



TO AVOID SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH:

- DO NOT EXCEED 5 MPH (8 KMH) WITH BLADE INSTALLED
- 2. OPERATE WITH EXTREME CAUTION ON SLOPES, STEEP GRADES, AND ROUGH TERRAIN
- 3. ALLOW NO RIDERS ON BLADE OR ATV WHILE MOVING OR STATIONARY
- KEEP BYSTANDERS AWAY FROM THE BLADE OR ATV WHILE MOVING OR STATIONARY
- 5. WHEN PUSHING HEAVY MATERIAL, DIRECTION CONTROL MAY BECOME DIFFICULT
- 6. BEFORE ADJUSTING BLADE: STOP ATV ENGINE; SET AND LOCK BRAKES; RAISE AND LOCK BLADE
- 7. LOWER BLADE TO DOWN POSITION WHEN BLADE AND ATV ARE NOT IN USE
- 8. READ BLADE INSTRUCTION SHEETS AND ATV OWNER'S MANUAL




VEHICLE PREPARATION


GENERAL

- Park vehicle on a flat surface.
- 2. Shift vehicle into park.
- 3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

- 4. If equipped, remove the tow hooks from front bumper and save for re-install later. Remove the plastic front lower grille located under the tow hooks/ front bumper. For the plastic grille removal, there will be two screws on the bottom and one screw on each side. This will provide access to the front vehicle frame to align plow mount to. (See illustrations 1-1 and 1-2). Note, if your vehicle has the plastic front lower grille, this part will not be re-installed with plow mount. Save for re-install when plow mount is removed for off-season.
- Newer models will have a different style bumper without front tow hooks. Remove the four OEM lower M8 x 60mm LG mounting bolts, spacer tube and locknuts. Save for re-install later. This will provide access to the front vehicle frame to align plow mount for installation. (See illustrations 1-2, 1-6 and 1-7).
- 6. Position the plow mounting bracket (item #1) to the front bumper and align the upper mounting holes with the tow hook / bumper holes. From the bottom side, use the two M10 bolts (item #2) and insert through the lower mounting holes through the vehicle skid plate and fasten on top skid plate, in front of gearcase, with M10 locknuts (item #3) as shown. (See illustrations 1-3, 1-4 and 1-5). Note, do not tighten hardware at this time.







ACCESSORY INSTALLATION (continued)

- Re-install the OEM tow hooks / OEM long M8 x 60mm bolts with spacers through the mount plate upper holes and fasten using the OEM locknuts on the backside of frame. (See illustrations 1-6 and 1-7).
- 8. Tighten hardware to specifications.

34 ft. lbs. (46 Nm)



All transportation costs incurred submitting product to Kolpin for warranty consideration must be borne by the purchaser. If Kolpin determines that the product must be returned to the factory for credit, please call 1-877-956-5746 for a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions.

This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect you and your ATV, certain parts of the plow system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the plow system and related components.

Peripheral products such as engines, electric motors, and actuators may carry an original manufacturer's warranty. Most hardware is general in nature and is easily obtained locally. Be sure to replace with minimum metric class 8.8 specification.
