Assembly and Mounting Instructions:

1. Remove Divider and Mounting Straps from the Guardian Storage Box.
2. The front and rear walls of the Guardian Storage Box come folded down. Fold up the front wall and tightly connect it to the velcro flap located on the upper front seam of the Guardian Storage Box.
3. Fold up the rear wall and tightly connect it to the velcro flap located on the upper rear seam of the Guardian Storage Box.
4. Insert the Divider in the desired position and secure it to the upper and lower velcro strips on the front and rear walls.
5. To install on an ATV, position the Guardian Storage Box on the Rear or Front Rack. Be sure the position doesn't obstruct the riders view, steering or controls while operating the vehicle. Route the Mounting Straps through the D-Rings located on the bottom of the Guardian Storage Box and connect them through the ATV Rack. Tighten each Strap. A minimum of (4) Mounting Straps is suggested.
6. To install on a UTV, position the Guardian Storage Box inside the rear bed of the UTV. Route the Mounting Straps through the D-Rings located on the bottom of the Guardian Storage Box and connect them to secure mounting points inside the rear bed of the UTV. Tighten each Strap. A minimum of (4) Mounting Straps is suggested.

Use and Care Information:

- Check the Mounting Straps frequently and retighten if necessary. Its recommended to inspect Mounting Straps before every ride.
- Its recommended to keep out of direct sunlight exposure during long periods of time.
- When this accessory becomes dirty, rinse thoroughly with cool water to remove loose dirt. Light duty fabric or upholstery cleaners can be used if necessary. Rinse with water after cleaners have been applied. Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline, thinner, benzene, acid or alkaline cleaners. Set out to dry with lid open for a minimum of 24 hours.

One Year Limited Warranty:

For the period of one (1) year from the purchase date, Kolpin will replace for the original purchaser, free of charge, any part or parts found upon examination by Kolpin to be defective in material, workmanship, or both. All transportation costs incurred submitting product to Kolpin for warranty consideration must be borne by the purchaser. If Kolpin determines that the product must be returned to the factory for credit, please call 1-877-956-5746 for a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions. This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect you and your ATV, certain parts of the accessory system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the accessory system and related components.
