We understand that unrelenting effort on and off the course is integral to the development of our industry and communities. In 2018, Polaris RZR will award one \$5,000 scholarship award to a racer who embodies these pillars and strives to be the very best.

// ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the parts program must be:

1. A current off-road racer in a recognized off-road racing series
2. Racing a Polaris RZR (any model)
3. Must be 17-18 years of age or currently enrolled in college

// AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the individuals award will be **\$5,000**. The scholarship is a one time award to the racer. Awards are intended to be used for the financial assistance in college or trade schools.

// APPLICATION

Interested racers must complete the application and submit it along with a current transcript of grades and verified racing results to Polaris Industries no later than May 31st. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, it is important to answer all questions as completely as possible.

All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Polaris Industries.

// SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, race experience, and statement of goals and aspirations.

All applicants will be notified at the end of June whether or not they have been awarded a scholarship.

// PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Polaris scholarship payments are authorized by and processed by Polaris. Checks will be mailed to each recipient's home address on August 15. Checks will be made payable to the school for the student.

// OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to Polaris. They are, however, required to notify of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested. Except as described in this brochure, no obligation is assumed by Polaris.

// REVISIONS

Polaris reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of the scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.

Polaris reserves the right to share the essays with the public if they so choose to. Names will be kept confidential unless otherwise approved by the applicant.

// IMPORTANT DATES

April 4th: Applications available from Polaris.

May 31st: Deadline for returning completed applications to Polaris. **Applications must be postmarked no later than May 31st to be considered for this year's program.**

End of June: Scholarship award announced by Polaris.

Mid-August: Award payment processed by Polaris, payable to the school for the student.
