


VEHICLE PREPARATION

- 1. Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface and vehicle is stable prior to installation.
- 2. Ensure exhaust is cooled before beginning.


REMOVAL

- 1. Remove RH saddlebag if equipped.
- 2. Loosen nuts (A) on muffler clamps at front of each muffler until clamps slide freely.







3. Remove and retain bolt (B) at rear of exhaust assembly connecting upper and lower mufflers together.




4. Remove and retain two bolts ©, washers D (if installed) and exhaust isolators E (if installed) connecting upper muffler to exhaust mount.



5. Remove upper muffler (F) by gently moving muffler up and down and side to side while sliding muffler assembly rearward.




6. Remove lower muffler © by gently moving muffler up and down and side to side while sliding muffler assembly rearward.




INSTALLATION


- 1. Transfer both exhaust clamps from stock mufflers to new mufflers.
- 2. Slide lower muffler ① onto rear head pipe assembly while loosely re-installing muffler clamp.




3. Slide upper muffler ② onto rear head pipe assembly while loosely re-installing muffler clamp.



4. Loosely install retained bolts ©, washers ® and exhaust isolators ® into recess in exhaust mount and loosely install bolt © to secure lower muffler ① to exhaust mount. DO NOT torque fasteners at this time.



5. Loosely install bolt (B) to secure upper and lower mufflers together. **DO NOT torque fasteners at this time.**



6. Ensure mufflers are properly aligned, torque bolts ® and ©. Then torque nuts A on muffler clamps. Ensure clamp orientation is correct.


TORQUE

Muffler Mount Bolts (B) and (C):

19 ft-lbs (25 N·m)

TORQUE

Nuts (A) on muffler clamps: 40 ft-lbs (54 N·m)



IMPORTANT

Update ECM with new calibration software using Calibration Card included in kit. This step must be completed by an **Authorized Indian Dealer**. Do not operate vehicle until re-calibration of vehicle is complete.

7. Reinstall RH saddlebag (if removed).
