



NOTE: Place motorcycle on firm surface on side stand.


Removal

- 1. It is recommended but not required to perform this procedure at a normal oil change interval.
- 2. Follow the Owner's Manual procedure for draining the oil and removing the oil filter.
- After the oil is drained and oil filter removed start by removing the oil filter adapter (A) by removing three screws (B) as shown in the figure.
- 4. Remove the two O-rings (C) behind the oil filter adapter. See figure.





Installation

- 1. Install two O-rings (6) provided in the kit on the engine side of the oil filter adapter (4) as shown in figure.
- 2. Install the oil filter adapter (4) using the three screws (7). Using an M5 Allen head socket torque screws to 84+/-9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).
- 3. Install filter adapter-straight onto the oil filter adapter and using and M12 Allen head socket. See figure. Torque the adapter to 22+/-2 ft. lbs. (30+/-2.7 Nm).



- 4. Apply P-80 O-ring lubricant to the O-rings prior to installation. Install back-up rings (10) and O-rings (6) to the hoses on the oil cooler (2). Starting with the lower hose by hand tightening the M6 screw (9). Torque screws using an M5 Allen head socket to 84+/- 9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).
- 5. Apply P-80 O-ring lubricant to the O-rings prior to installation. Install upper hose by hand tightening the M6 screw (9). See figure. Torque screws using an M5 Allen head socket to 84+/-9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).
- 6. Apply a light film of oil to the oil filter seal and install oil filter. Torque to 70+/-5 in-lbs. (8+/-0.6 Nm).
- Install both lower mounts prior to mounting the oil cooler (2) to the bike. On the lower right side of the bike install the grommet and insert (1) with the rubber side contacting the frame of the bike. Use one screw (8) and tighten using a 10 mm socket as shown in figure. Torque to 84+/-9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).
- 8. On the lower left side of the bike install the spacer (11) into the bushing (5) and using a 10 mm socket as shown in figure. Torque the screws (8) to 84+/- 9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).





- 9. Rotate the oil cooler slightly forward and gently lift the oil cooler base of the bottom grommets to properly mount the oil cooler.
- 10. In the top mount of the oil cooler install screw (8) and using a 10 mm socket. Torque to 84+/- 9 in-lbs. (10+/-1 Nm).
- 11. Perform oil fill procedure per the owner's manual.
