



VEHICLE PREPARATION


GENERAL

NOTE Allow exhaust to cool before performing installation.


- Turn key or ignition switch to **OFF** position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.
- 2. Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface, kickstand is fully extended, and vehicle is stable prior to installation.
- 3. Remove saddlebags (if equipped) as per owner's manual.

REMOVE STOCK MUFFLERS

1. Loosen screw clamp (A) on both rear muffler heatshields.




2. Loosen muffler clamp nuts (B) at front of both mufflers.




3. Remove and retain two screws © from each muffler mount.

NOTE

If equipped, ensure antenna and antenna mount are secured when removing and reattached when assembling.




4. Slide muffler assemblies (1) rearward to remove.




ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

1. Transfer muffler clamps from stock mufflers to new mufflers 1 and 2.




2. Slide new mufflers onto rear head pipe and loosely install two retained screws © in each muffler bracket. **DO NOT** torque fasteners at this time.




3. Adjust clamps into place as shown. Align mufflers and torque clamp nuts [®] to specification.

Muffler Clamp Nuts (B): 40 ft-lbs (54 N·m)



4. Torque muffler bracket screws © to specification.

TORQUE Muffler Bracket Screws ©: 18 ft-lbs (24 N·m)



5. Position heat shield and tighten screw clamp to specification.

TORQUE

Exhaust heat shield screw clamp: 36 in-lbs (4 N·m)

- 6. Reinstall saddlebags (if equipped) as per owner's manual procedure.
- 7. Update ECM with new calibration software using included Calibration Card ③

IMPORTANT

This step must be completed by an Authorized Indian® Dealer. Do not operate vehicle until recalibration of vehicle is complete.
