


VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL


- 1. Turn key or ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.
- Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface, kickstand is fully extended, and vehicle is stable prior to installation.

STRUT COVER REMOVAL

1. Remove and discard two screws (A) from each Strut Cover (B). Remove and discard left and right Strut Covers (B).




2. Remove and discard two screws © and washers (not shown, if applicable) from each side of rear fender.




ACCESSORY INSTALLATION


1. Identify left and right strut covers from kit. Left cover ① has an "L" inside and right cover ② has an "R" inside as shown.



2. Loosely install left strut cover ① with two new fasteners ③. Do not torque fasteners at this time.



3. Slide plastic bushing ④ over runner bushing ⑤. Install assembled parts into hole in fender strut cover ① and loosely install new specialty screw
⑥. Repeat for second hole in fender strut cover.



4. Torque Specialty screws 6 to specification.

TORQUE

Specialty Screws 6: 32 ft. lbs. (44 Nm)

5. Torque new strut cover screws ② (installed in step 2 of this section) to specification.

TORQUE

84 in. lbs. (9.5 Nm)

6. Repeat this section for the right fender strut cover (2).

NOTE

Retain four screws (8) and four bushings (7) for use with saddlebag kit if purchased.
