


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn key or ignition switch to OFF position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.
- 2. Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface, kickstand is fully extended, and vehicle is stable prior to installation.

SEAT REMOVAL


1. Remove side panels (A).

Side panels (A) are attached with built-in push pin rivets and can be taken off by hand if pulled firmly on both ends of panel.




- 2. Remove driver seat (E) and (if applicable) passenger seat (F).
 - a. Remove two screws (B), one from each side of driver seat (E).
 - b. (If applicable) Remove screw C and washer
 D from passenger seat fender mount.



c. Lift and slide attached driver E and (if **applicable**) passenger F seats backwards.



d. (If applicable) Separate passenger seat F
from driver seat E by removing four screws
6 from underside of seats.




SOLO LUGGAGE RACK INSTALLATION

1. Slide luggage rack mount (2) into upside down driver seat (E) and install with two screws (4).


Torque two screws ④ to specification.

TORQUE

84 in. lb. (9.5 Nm)



- 2. Reinstall driver seat E.
 - a. Slide driver seat (E), with luggage rack mount
 (2) installed, forward until it slides into two hooks near gas tank.




b. Reinstall two screws (B), removed in Step 2a of Seat Removal section.

Torque two screws (B) to specification.



c. Reinstall side panels (A), removed in Step 1 of Seat Removal section




- 3. Install solo luggage rack ① with protective cover placed over fender to prevent damage.
 - a. Loosely install solo luggage rack ① to rack mount ② with two screws ③.




b. Install screw (3), two washers (5), and one nylon washer (6) to fender mount.

Torque screw 3 to specification.





c. Torque two screws ③, connecting luggage rack ① to rack mount ②, to specification.



IMPORTANT Re-torque fasteners after 500 miles (800 km) of riding.
