




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

HARDWARE INSTALLATION


1. Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface, kickstand is fully extended, and vehicle is stable prior to installation.
2. Raise windshield to highest position.
3. Turn key or ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.
4. Remove and retain two screws **A** from fairing bezel **B**.




5. Remove fairing bezel **B** by gently pulling out from top.



6. Loosen (**Do NOT remove**) farthest right dashboard screw **C** below windshield for access.




7. Clean upper surface of GPS Mounting Bracket **D** with solvent wipe. Bracket is located just below screw **C** (loosened in previous step).






8. Peel backing paper from GPS Antenna ① and install onto bracket ④ as shown. Press firmly in place to set adhesive.




9. Remove zip tie holding GPS Antenna Connector ⑤ in place and plug GPS Antenna Connector ⑤ into GPS Antenna ①.



10. Tighten dashboard screw ③ (Loosened in step 6) to specification.




11. Reinstall headlight bezel ②. Tighten screws ① to specification.



DOWNLOADING MAP FILES

1. Navigate to my.indianmotorcycle.com/ridecommand or click link if viewing on a PC and follow on-screen instructions to complete map download.

APPLY UPDATE



On Your Motorcycle

1. Connect Indian® branded USB drive ② to USB cable located in storage area above display.
2. Navigate to *Settings* menu of touchscreen display.
3. Select *General Settings*.
4. Select *Update Maps*.
5. Select *Create Key*. Key will load onto USB drive ②.

On Your Computer

1. Launch Map Update Application.
2. Connect USB Drive ② (with key on it) to computer.
3. Follow instructions in Map Update Application.
4. Select map region you would like to download.
5. Map Update Application will ask for Map Coupon Code before beginning download.
6. Once download is completed, safely remove USB Drive ② from computer.

Return to Motorcycle

1. Connect Indian® branded USB drive ② to USB cable located in storage area above display.
2. Turn on motorcycle and power up display.
3. Navigate to *Settings* menu of touchscreen display.
4. Select *General Settings*.
5. Select *Update Maps*.
6. Select *Continue*. This may take up to 30 minutes to complete.
7. Select *Yes* to restart display.
8. You are now ready to ride!
