



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn key or ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.
- 2. Ensure motorcycle is parked on a flat surface, kickstand is fully extended, and vehicle is stable prior to installation.
- 3. Remove driver seat from vehicle as per owner's manual.
- Remove and retain four fasteners (A). Remove LH
 (B) and RH (C) side strut covers. Carefully hang strut cover assemblies.

CAUTION


Once all four fasteners are removed, fender will be loose and can move freely. Use caution to ensure damage does not occur to fender finish, taillight housings or wiring.




5. Place a clean towel over top of fender to protect from scratches during installation.

6. Carefully lower rack ① over top of fender (Do not set on fender). Hand start four new screws
② and washers ③. Remove towel. Torque screws to specification.


TORQUE 18 ft. lbs. (24 Nm)



7. Remove rubber blanks © from each strut cover.



- 8. Ensure rear light wiring is properly secured in strut covers (shown with arrow) and hand start strut cover and rear fender mounting screws (A). Confirm rear light wiring is positioned to avoid pinching and torque screws to specification.
 - **TORQUE** 84 in. lbs. (9.5 Nm)
