


VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL


- 1. Park motorcycle on a flat surface, fully extend kickstand, and make sure vehicle is stable.
- 2. Turn key or ignition switch to OFF position and remove key. If equipped with keyless fob, remove fob from proximity of vehicle.

MOTORCYCLES WITH PASSENGER FOOT PEGS RIGHT HAND HEEL GUARD REMOVAL

1. Remove the right hand heel guard fasteners (A).



2. Remove the right hand heel guard (B).





SIDE COVERS REMOVAL




1. Remove three side cover fasteners (A).




2. Remove the side cover (B).

SADDLEBAG SUPPORT INSTALLATION (MOTORCYCLES WITHOUT FOOT PEGS)


NOTICE

1. Attach right hand saddlebag support 6 to frame with two saddlebag support screws 2. Torque to specification.

TORQUE


Saddlebag Support Screws ①: 35 ft-lbs (47.5 N·m)



2. Attach right hand side cover bracket (1) to the motorcycle with the side cover bracket fasteners (2). Torque to specification.

TORQUE


Side Cover Bracket Fasteners ©: 35 in-lbs (4 N·m)



3. Attach right hand side cover ® to the motorcycle with three retained side cover fasteners (A). Torque to specification.




SADDLEBAG ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

1. Loosely assemble the bracket ① and right hand saddlebag support assembly ④ to the saddlebag ② with four screws ①.

Do NOT torque fasteners at this time.




2. Put a rubber flange bushing ② from previously installed Accessory Spool Kit (P/N 2884925) in the end of the saddlebag spools.



3. Put saddlebag on previously installed Accessory Spool Kit (P/N 2884925).

IMPORTANT

Make sure the saddlebag's hook is seated in the spool bushing's groove.




4. Loosely install shoulder bolts (5) from Accessory Spool Kit (P/N 2884925) through inside of saddlebag.

Do NOT torque fasteners at this time.



5. Attach the right hand saddlebag support assembly 4 to right hand saddlebag support 6 with two screws 0. Torque screws to specification.

TORQUE

Saddlebag Support Screws (10): 18 ft-lbs (25 N·m)




6. Torque saddlebag shoulder bolts 5 to specification.

TORQUE

Saddlebag Shoulder Bolts 5: 13 ft-lbs (18 N·m)


7. Torque saddlebag support arm screws ① to specification.



8. Attach the cargo limit decal (9) to the inside of the saddlebag.

NOTICE

REFLECTOR INSTALLATION

1. Clean the lower, outside face of saddlebag with a 50:50 mixture of isopropyl alcohol and water.


MARNING

Isopropyl alcohol is hazardous to your health. See isopropyl alcohol packaging for proper handling instructions, including recommended personal protective equipment such as goggles and chemical resistant gloves.

- 2. Remove tape backing from the reflector 8.
- 3. Position the reflector at a point that is at the center between the lid straps and 1 3/8 in (33 mm) above the bottom edge of the saddlebag. Press firmly against the reflector for at least 5 seconds to attach it to the saddlebag.

IMPORTANT

Make sure surfaces are warm before bonding the reflector to the saddlebag.
