


## **Assembly Time:** Approximately 15 minutes

**Important:** This Kolpin Roof is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.


#### Installation Instructions:

- Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- Remove two OEM screws from upper rear side of the OEM Visor as shown. The two OEM screws will not be reused. The Roof will be installed over the OEM Visor. (See Illustration 1-1).

Note: If desired, this Roof can also be assembled with the OEM Visor completely removed.




 Remove the two OEM Nut Clips on the roll cage (under the visor) which were attached to the OEM Screws from Step 2 . The OEM Nut Clips will not be reused. (See Illustration 1-2).




4. This is an optional step to suppress vibration between Poly Roof and OEM Visor.

Cut four separate pieces of Adhesive Backed Foam to the lengths shown below. Peel off adhesive backing and adhere each piece to the Visor in the locations shown. (See Illustration 1-3).

Piece A: 16.75" (Qty 1)
Piece B: 16.00" (Qty 1)
Piece C: 1.50" (Qty 2)



Note: If desired, the Foam pieces can be adhered to the matching location on the under side of the Poly Roof. 5. Place Roof onto the roll cage and align the 4 mounting holes. (See Illustration 1-4).



 Loosely install the M6 x 25mm Torx Screws (Item #2), Oversize Washer (Item #4) and Flanged Lock Nut (Item #5) on two rear mounting holes. Be sure not to cross thread fasteners. (See Illustration 1-5).



 Loosely install the M6 x 45mm Torx Screws (Item #2), Oversize Washer (Item #4) and Flanged Lock Nut (Item #5) on two front mounting holes. Be sure not to cross thread fasteners. (See Illustration 1-6).



- 8. Align and center Roof to desired position before tightening hardware.
- 9. Tighten all hardware to specification.



### **FASTENER TORQUE:**

4.5 ft. lbs. (54 in-lb) (6.1 Nm)

10. Re-inspect hardware after riding.

#### **Use and Care Information:**

- Check the accessory mounts frequently and retighten hardware if necessary.
- If transporting vehicle in a non-enclosed trailer, it's suggested to put vehicle facing forward to reduce the risk of accessory separating from vehicle.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight.
- · Replace this accessory with a new one if it is damaged.
- Do not use brush while cleaning this accessory as it may leave scratches on the surface.
- Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline, thinner, benzene, acid or alkaline cleaners.

This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect you and your ATV, certain parts of the accessory system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the plow system and related components.
