

Assembly Time: Approximately 15 minutes

Important: This Kolpin Roof is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. Attach three 1.75" Clamps (Item # 3) to the Rear Roof (Item #1) before placing on vehicle. Each 1.75" Clamp (Item #3) uses two Lock Washers (Item #5) and two Button Head Hex Screw (Item #6). The Clamp should be mounted so it opens in the direction shown. Do not fully tighten fasteners yet. The holes next to the outer clamps are for draining water that may leak through the seam. (See Illustration 1-1).



 Place Rear Roof (Item #1) onto the roll cage with 1.75" Clamps connected to the round tube crossmember. Loosely install one Lock Washer (Item #5) and Button Head Hex Screw (Item #6) into each Clamp to keep it closed. (See Illustration 1-2).




- 4. Loosely install four Torx Screws M6 x 25mm (Item #7) and Nylon Spacers (Item #8) on the back of the Rear Roof as shown. The Nylon Spacers go between the Poly Roof and the Roll Cage. The Torx Screws will self tap threads into the OEM holes in the roll cage. (See Illustration 1-3).
- Align and center the Rear Roof section to desired







 Remove backing from Adhesive Backed Foam Seal (Item #10) and adhere to Rear Roof as shown. Position the Seal on the recessed surface in front of the holes that will fasten the Front Roof section. Trim any excess Seal material beyond position shown. (See Illustration 1-4)




 Place the Front Roof (Item #2) section onto the Roll Cage and align the mounting holes. (See Illustration 1-5).




8. Loosely install ten M6 x 25mm Torx Screws (Item #2) and Flanged Lock Nuts (Item #9) to connect the Front Roof to the Rear Roof. Be sure not to cross thread fasteners. (See Illustration 1-6).



 Loosely install five Torx Screws - M6 x 25mm (Item #7) and Flanged Lock Nuts (Item #9) in the front mounting holes. Be sure not to cross thread fasteners. (See Illustration 1-7).



- Align and center Front Roof to desired position before tightening hardware.
- 11. Tighten all hardware to specification.



12. Re-inspect hardware after riding.

Use and Care Information:

- Check the accessory mounts frequently and retighten hardware if necessary.
- If transporting vehicle in a non-enclosed trailer, it's suggested to put vehicle facing forward to reduce the risk of accessory separating from vehicle.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight.
- Replace this accessory with a new one if it is damaged.
- Do not use brush while cleaning this accessory as it may leave scratches on the surface.
- Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline, thinner, benzene, acid or alkaline cleaners.
