





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. Remove driver's (or left rear passenger) seat and disconnect black negative (-) cable from battery.
- 3. Gain Access.
 - a. Remove hood.
 - b. Remove windshield.
 - c. Remove two screws (A) securing front of upper dash panel, then carefully pull panel rearward, disengaging seven retaining clips (B) as shown.

If necessary for access, label and disconnect other electrical harnesses from control panel.






4. Install amplifier ① and bracket ④ to vehicle frame cross-member using four each screws ② and nuts ③.



- 5. Route electrical harness ring terminals forward though firewall grommet and connect to terminal block:
 - RED harness wire: To post with existing RED battery connection cable (unswitched 12V POS); post may be identified as "BAT"
 - BLACK harness wire: To post with existing BLACK battery connection cable (12V NEG); post may be identified as "GND"
- Join 4–pin connector © from amplifier to mating 4–pin connector from Dash Radio Kit (PN 2881988, purchased separately), Bluetooth® Remote Kit (PN 2881470, purchased separately), or other compatible audio component.



- 7. Join bullet connector (blue wire) ® from amplifier to mating bullet connector from Dash Radio Kit (PN 2881988, purchased separately), Bluetooth® Remote Kit (PN 2881470, purchased separately), or other compatible audio component.
- 8. Join each 2–pin connector **(E)** from amplifier to mating connectors on LH and RH speaker harness(es).

NOTE

RH side has grey wires, LH side has white wires.

- Remove rubber plug on opposite end of amplifier to gain access to gain control. Adjust as required to equalize signal between door panel speakers and other audio components, then reinstall plug.
- 10. Restore access.
- 11. Reconnect black negative (-) cable to battery and reinstall seat.
