


**NOTE:** This windshield is made of laminate safety glass and should be treated with care when installing and storing.

## APPROXIMATE ASSEMBLY TIME: 30 minutes


**IMPORTANT:** Your Polaris FRONT TIPOUT WINDSHIELD KIT is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Two people should work together to carefully remove windshield from box. The installation of this windshield kit is easier to accomplish with two people.
- 2. Remove dash cap by removing four plastic darts. Figure 1.




3. Install the hinges (PN 1018927 LH; PN 1018927 RH) onto the windshield. Figure 2.




4. Remove any roof you may have installed on your vehicle. Set the windshield in place. Figure 3.

**NOTE:** It is recommended for the ease of installation that two people lift the windshield into place.

- Install bolts through windshield hinges and grommet (PN 5522061) to holes provided on vehicle frame. To allow for adjustments, snug just one bolt each side. Open and close the windshield a couple of time to make sure it is centered on vehicle. Once this is accomplished, torque bolts to 20 ft. lbs. (27 Nm). Figure 3.
- 6. Install ball studs to the frame mount on each side. Torque to 12 ft. lbs. (16.2 Nm). Figure 4.






7. Slip shocks onto ball studs on the vehicle and the windshield.

**IMPORTANT:** Orient shock correctly with the shock body (thick part of shock) at the bottom with the shock rod at the top attached to the ball studs. Figure 5.

8. Reinstall dash cap.



**IMPORTANT:** Only move the windshield with the tip out handle. If you grab or push out the windshield glass to open and close, you could cause damage to the windshield. Figure 6.
