





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. Remove two screws (A) (out of ten) holding rear rack (B) on rear cab frame as shown.




3. For remaining eight screws (A), remove nuts (C) from underside of the rear cab frame (D) on both sides.



4. Remove rear rack (B) along with the support tube (E) by removing eight screws (A) as shown.




5. Install spacers (2) on rear cab frame (D) at ten locations as shown.




Install two screws ④ onto the front spacers. Install nuts ⑤ onto these screws from underside of rear cab frame (D) as shown. Tighten nuts until snug.


NOTE

Two screws ④ and spacers shown below do not attach to the rack, but are used to cover the holes exposed by removal of the plastic rack (B). The remaining spacers are all in direct contact with the rack.






7. Mount rear rack ① onto the installed spacers ② as shown. Ensure the hole locations on rear rack align with holes on spacers.



8. Install eight screws ④ onto rear rack ① passing through spacers ② and rear cab frame (D).



9. Install nuts (5) onto screws (4) from underside of rear cab frame (D) on both sides of vehicle.
