


#### **VEHICLE PREPARATION**

#### **GENERAL**

- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into PARK.
- 2. Turn key to OFF position and remove from vehicle.


## CENTER HOOD PANEL REMOVAL

1. Remove and keep two hood fasteners (a). Move hood towards rear of vehicle to remove.



#### DASHBOARD STORAGE REMOVAL


1. Open center dashboard storage compartment.



2. Remove storage compartment from dashboard.

#### TIP

If removing storage compartment is difficult, carefully use tool to pry storage compartment upwards where marked "LIFT HERE."




#### DASHBOARD TOP REMOVAL


1. Carefully pull up to remove left, center, and right dashboard trim pieces.

#### TIP

Release steering tilt lock for improved access.




2. Open glove box lid. Remove and retain four dashboard fasteners around glove box opening.




3. Remove and retain three front dashboard fasteners around glove box opening.

## TIP


Make note of different screw sizes in steps 2 and 3.




 Tilt steering wheel down. Remove and retain four dashboard fasteners from dashboard surrounding steering wheel.




5. Remove and retain two dashboard fasteners from front of vehicle.




6. Remove and retain two push-pin rivets from front side hood panels.



7. Carefully lift edge of left front hood panel to release tab from dashboard top as shown.




8. Carefully lift edge of right front hood panel to release tab from dashboard top as shown.



9. Carefully keep panels up-and-away from tabs and remove dashboard top by tilting rear section up and pulling out toward rear.



Two people are recommended to complete this step.




#### ACCESSORY MOUNTING PANEL REMOVAL


#### **IMPORTANT**

Disconnect harnesses from Polaris Pulse® bar (not including positive and ground cables) and accessory mounting panel before proceeding with removal.


1. Remove and retain five push-pin rivets from accessory mounting panel.



2. Remove and retain two mounting panel fasteners.



3. Move accessory mounting panel from beneath Polaris Pulse® bar and remove from vehicle.




#### **ACCESSORY INSTALLATION**

#### AMPLIFIER INSTALLATION

1. Install amplifier ① onto accessory mounting panel with four amplifier fasteners ①. Pass bottom-right fastener through ground jumper (5) before passing through amplifier. Ensure amplifier connector is facing downward.




- 2. Return accessory mounting panel, with amplifier installed, to install position.
- 3. Secure front of accessory mounting panel with two retained fasteners.

4. Reinstall rear of accessory mounting panel with five retained push-pin rivets.




5. Reinstall audio harness to accessory mounting panel and Polaris Pulse ® bar.


#### TWEETER SPEAKER INSTALLATION

#### **RIGHT TWEETER INSTALLATION**


1. Slide A-pillar cover upwards along ROPS.




2. From underside of A-pillar cover, insert one tweeter speaker ② into tweeter cover.



3. Lower A-pillar cover down and reinstall.




4. Ensure tweeter cable routes into underdashboard. Ensure A-pillar cover is completely seated into body plastic.




5. Join tweeter connector to audio harness.

## **LEFT TWEETER INSTALLATION**


1. Slide A-pillar cover upwards along ROPS.




2. From underside of A-pillar cover, insert one tweeter speaker ② into tweeter cover.



3. Lower A-pillar cover down and reinstall.



4. Ensure tweeter cable routes into underdashboard. Ensure A-pillar cover is completely seated into body plastic.




5. Join tweeter connector to audio harness.


#### **DRIVER SPEAKER INSTALLATION**

### RIGHT DRIVER INSTALLATION

1. Remove and retain two speaker grille fasteners (A) to remove speaker panel from vehicle.




2. Tilt right-hand driver assembly ③ up-and-into installed position. Ensure driver cable routes upwards into under-dashboard.



3. Loosely install speaker with two speaker fasteners§. After both fasteners are installed, torque fasteners to specification.



4. Install speaker to dashboard panel with four fasteners ③.



5. Join driver connector to audio harness.


6. Install Rockford Fosgate® badge ⑥ onto speaker panel with two push nuts ⑩.



7. Reinstall speaker panel with two retained fasteners (A).






## **LEFT DRIVER INSTALLATION**

1. Remove and retain two speaker panel fasteners (A) to remove speaker panel from vehicle.




2. Tilt right-hand driver assembly ③ up-and-into installed position. Ensure driver cable routes upwards into under-dashboard.



3. Loosely install speaker with two speaker fasteners§. After both fasteners are installed, torque fasteners to specification.







#### **VEHICLE REASSEMBLY**

#### **GENERAL**


1. Make sure speakers operate properly before proceeding with reassembling vehicle.

#### DASHBOARD TOP INSTALLATION


1. Carefully lift panels up-and-away from tabs and install dashboard top into place by tilting rear section up and installing front section first, then lower rear section into place.

#### TIP

Two people are recommended to complete this step.




Ensure that tabs on panels are aligned in slots on dashboard top. (Passenger-side panel shown; driver-side panel similar.)



3. Ensure that both rubber boots are properly seated around hood panels. Only upper lip should be visible, as shown with inset.


#### TIP

Push up on inside of fender to ease installation.




4. Reinstall two retained front dashboard fasteners into front edge of top dashboard.

# TORQUE Front Dashboard Fasteners: 88 in-lbs (10 N·m)




5. Install hood panels to with two retained push-pin rivets



6. Tilt steering wheel down. Install four retained screws through dashboard top and torque to specification.







Release steering tilt lock for improved access.




#### **CENTER HOOD PANEL INSTALLATION**

1. Move panel forward until tabs slide into front hood panel and install with two hood fasteners.




Hood Fasteners: 88 in-lbs (10 N·m)
