INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. Gain access.
 - a. Remove visor by removing two screws (A). Retain screws.




b. Remove RH A-pillar access cover ® by grasping rear inboard corner of cover with fingers, then lift to detach three locking tabs ©, two posts ®, and two locking tabs €. Set cover aside.




NOTE View of underside of cover looking rearward.






c. Remove RH rear fender by unlocking quarter turn latch (f) and unhooking two straps (g).




d. Remove five screws (#) securing exterior body panel to frame. Retain screws.




e. From outside of vehicle, and while supporting exterior body panel, remove final screw ①, then remove panel by detaching locking tab ⑥ from mating slot ① in front fender. Set panel aside.

3. Install ROPS harness.


NOTE

See previous section, **HARNESS DETAIL**, for connector identification.

a. Route two bullet connectors 3B and 3C on ROPS harness ③ into hole at top of RH side Apillar, down ROPS, and out of welded coupler at base of pillar.

NOTE

Connection to dash harness will occur in Step 4d.




- b. Install grommet 3D in hole at top of RH side Apillar.
- c. Join light connector 3A to mating light connector (light sold separately).
- d. Secure ROPS harness ③ using cable ties ④ to prevent contact with hot components, sharp edges, or moving parts.

4. Install dash harness.


NOTE

See previous section, **HARNESS DETAIL**, for connector identification.

a. Install relay/fuse block 1A on dash harness ① to upper dash panel using attached fir tree clip.



- b. Open power cap on vehicle terminal block at any open location, then plug in connector 1B.
- c. Route opposite end of harness ① beneath upper dash panel towards base of RH ROPS A-pillar.




- d. Join two bullet connectors 1C and 1D on dash harness ① to mating bullet connectors 3B and 3C on ROPS harness ③, matching wire colors (red to red, and brown to brown).
- e. Carefully cut out one rectangular switch blank
 M from RH console panel. Debur hole edges as required.

IMPORTANT

Control cut depth to prevent damage to underlying structure or components.

NOTE

Any open location may be used.




- f. Route connector 1E upward through switch opening, join to switch ②, then install switch into panel.
- g. Secure upper edge clip 1F to horizontal support member (inboard of chassis tubing), and lower edge clip 1F to panel flange.

TIP

Upper edge clip 1F can be installed by reaching down through A-pillar access cover opening.

NOTE

Front fender hidden for clarity.



- h. Secure harness ① using cable ties ④ to prevent contact with hot components, sharp edges, or moving parts.
- 5. Restore access.
