



GENERAL


1. Shift vehicle transmission into PARK. Turn key to OFF position and remove from vehicle.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

1. Snap hoop (2) and latch (3) into clamp base (1).




2. Test hoop and latch movement to ensure both are fully installed.




3. For aggressive riding conditions: Prepare rear panel for mounting. Drill one hole through each doghouse and up through roof panel.

MEASUREMENT


Measurement (A): 5/16 in (8 mm)




4. Install each clamp assembly onto front roof panel with four clamp fasteners (9).



5. If vehicle is equipped with windshield: Install seal (6) onto ridge of roof front roof panel.




6. Apply foam tape ① to front ridge of rear roof panel.




 Place both roof panels upside down on clean surface. Overlap front roof panel with rear panel. Connect two panels with nine roof fasteners (9).






8. Insert bracket (1) into front roof panel and secure with one bracket fastener (6).

TORQUE Bracket Fasteners (6): 8 ft-lbs (11 N·m)




9. With assistance, place roof assembly on top of ROPS. Ensure roof panels hook onto rear cross beam and center cross beam.




10. Pass one fastener through ROPS weldment and into roof bracket. Repeat this step for opposite side.

11. Install front roof panel onto front cross beam with clamps.


