




#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### **REMOVAL OF REAR DECK HUMP PANEL**


- Put transmission in "NEUTRAL" and turn key to "OFF" position. Remove key from vehicle. Apply parking brake.



3. Carefully pull RH panel <sup>(B)</sup> up, starting from front and working back until entire panel is removed.




- 4. Remove gas cap and repeat Step 2 on left side rear deck hump panel.
- 5. Carefully remove large nut  ${\mathbb C}$  surrounding gas filler neck  ${\mathbb D}.$



6. Carefully pull LH panel up, starting from front and working back until entire panel is removed.


# **REMOVAL OF UPPER TRIM ACCENT**

 Carefully pull center upper trim accent panel starting from front. Work all the way back until panel is completely removed.




#### **REMOVAL OF HOOD ACCENT**


- 1. Ensure parking brake is engaged and open hood.
- 2. Starting on right side, remove and retain twelve screws (F) as shown with circles from hood underside attached to hood accent panel.




3. Remove and retain one screw (6) from front tip of panel.




4. Carefully start pulling panel (#) starting at vehicle dash.



5. When a tape patch ① is reached use a heat gun to help loosen adhesive before prying panel up. Use caution to not over heat paint or scratch hood.



6. Finish removing panel (1) by carefully pulling component from its front tip working backward towards rear. Disengage three molded tabs (shown with arrow)above front light.



7. Repeat Steps 2-6 for left side hood accent.

# HOOD ACCENT INSTALLATION

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
Follow all chemical manufacturer instructions and safety precautions. Failure to follow all manufacturer instructions and precautions may result in severe injury or death.

Clean any extra glue left by tape patches 


 with adhesive remover and clean adhesion surface with solvent wipe.

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Isopropyl alcohol is hazardous to your health. See isopropyl alcohol packaging for proper handling instructions, including recommended personal protective equipment such as goggles and chemical resistant gloves.  Starting on right side, install five tape patches onto surface of hood. Using heat gun, slightly warm hood surface before applying tape patch.




- 3. Close and latch hood.
- 4. Starting with front of right hood accent panel ④ align panel tabs with slots in vehicle and firmly press until tabs engage.



5. Install retained screw <sup>(6)</sup> located in front tip of panel adjacent to light and torque to specification.

# TORQUE Hood Trim Screw (6): 36 in. lbs. (4 Nm)



- 6. Working from front to back lay panel ④ down. Use a heat gun to slightly warm panel surface before firmly pressing it on to each tape patch.
- Re-install screws (F) from bottom of hood. Removed in Step 2 (Section - Removal of Hood Accent). Torque screws to specification.



# INSTALLATION OF UPPER TRIM ACCENT


1. Starting with back of upper trim accent panel (5), insert accent tab into slot located on vehicle.



2. Work from back towards front of vehicle, firmly press on trim (5). Ensure tabs engage.


#### **INSTALLATION OF REAR DECK HUMP PANEL**

 Start with right rear deck hump panel. Work from back forward to engage all tabs to install the panel
 (2).




 Reinstall bolts (A) at front of panel (2). Removed in Step 2 (Section - Removal of Rear Deck Hump Panel). Torque screws (A) to specification.

- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to install left rear deck hump panel ①.
- Reinstall retained nut 
   C around gas filler neck 
   D. Removed in Step 5 (Section - Removal of Rear Deck Hump Panel).
- 5. Install Gas Cap 6.
