

CAN-AM X3 Striker Cage Install Instructions (CA162CO32)

TOOLS REQUIRED

- » SAFETY GLASSES/GLOVES/ FLAME RESISITANT BLANKET
- » SAWZALL (RECIPROCATING SAW)
- » T27 TORX WRENCH
- » Drill/Drill bit

- » TORQUE WRENCH
- » 17MM SOCKET/WRENCH
- » ALLEN WRENCH/SOCKET



Once Cage has been removed you will need to mask off the area around the plates with masking tape or painters tape and spray paint them so they don't rust.



Once the paint dries remove the tape and place the cab section of your new Pro Armor Striker cage into position on the mounting plates.



Use 16 m10 bolts and nuts supplied in the hardware pack and fasten cage to mounting plates at each pillar location (4). (washers not needed because both bolts & nuts are flanged!)



Torque the 16 Cage bolts to 50 lb. ft.



Now you are ready to install the rear section of the cage. You must install it to the cab section from the top first. Fasten with the 4 M8 Allen head bolts into both bungs.



You can now attach the lower part of the rear section to the car using the factory hardware. You will need to wiggle and adjust both rear wheels to align the bolts properly. Don't get frustrated this takes some patience! It helps to raise and lower the car with a jack until you get them aligned. You will not be able to get them all aligned at once so fasten the nuts one at a time until all 6 are on and lined up properly.



Torque all 6 bolts to factory specifications.
